



NISD students **WILL NOT** have to make up bad weather day; teachers, staff **WILL**

- NISD students **WILL NOT** have to make up the bad weather day from January 16 because there are enough minutes of instruction built into the 2017-18 calendar. State law requires students receive at least 75,600 minutes of instruction, and the NISD 2017-18 calendar exceeds that.
- For the same reason, Raguet Elementary students that missed January 24 because of the problem with the school's heating system **WILL NOT** have to make up the missed day.
- NISD teachers and staff, however, **WILL** have to make up the bad weather day (January 16) and that will occur Monday, April 2, one of two bad weather days built into Nacogdoches ISD's 2017-18 calendar. (The other is Good Friday, March 30, which students and staff will have off, barring any other closures because of weather.) The make-up day for staff is required because state law mandates teachers work a set number of days (187), while student attendance is measured by minutes at school.
