



## **Nacogdoches ISD COVID-19 Safety Response Plan**

### **Prevention**

---

No confirmed cases of COVID-19 among staff or students.

- Health prevention/protective measures are in place.
- Daily intensive cleaning and frequent cleaning of common areas.
- Monitoring virus trends in the community via the health department.
- No visitor access.
- Parents are responsible for screening their children daily.
- All students riding a bus will have their temperatures taken prior to boarding the bus.
- Elementary school children will have their temperatures taken upon arriving to campus.
- Secondary students will have their temperatures taken if it is suspected that the student has a temperature and/or symptoms.
- Social Distancing

### **Mitigation**

---

One or more confirmed case(s) of COVID-19 at one campus/facility

- Persons who are determined to have been in “close contact” (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer) with an individual who is confirmed COVID-19 positive will be personally contacted by phone and will be required to self-quarantine for 14 days and work/learn remotely.
- Individuals in the same class but not considered to be in “close contact” will be notified by letter and asked to monitor symptoms for 14 days.
- Affected areas are temporarily closed for deep cleaning.

### **Modified Operations**

---

Three (3) or more confirmed COVID-19 cases in one specific area (i.e. classroom)

- Persons who are determined to have been in “close contact” (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer) with an individual who is confirmed COVID-19 positive will be personally contacted by phone and will be required to self-quarantine for 14 days and work/learn remotely.
- Individuals in the same class but not considered to be in “close contact” will be notified by letter and asked to monitor symptoms for 14 days.
- Affected areas are temporarily closed for deep cleaning.
- A short-term transition to remote learning may be necessary for the specific area for the quarantine period.

### **Campus/Facility Closure**

COVID-19 confirmed positive cases exceed 20% of the in-person campus/facility population **or** Staff is unable to operate effectively with in-person learning.

- Entire campus/facility will be closed for in-person learning and transitioned to remote learning for up to 5 days for deep cleaning.
- Persons who are determined to have been in “close contact” (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer) with an individual who is confirmed COVID-19 positive will be personally contacted by phone and will be required to self-quarantine for 14 days and work/learn remotely.
- Individuals in the same class but not considered to be in “close contact” will be notified by letter and asked to monitor symptoms and are expected to return to school upon reopening.
- District/campus communication to staff/parents with health monitoring guidance.

### **District Closure**

COVID-19 confirmed positive cases exceed 10% of in-person population **or** when the district is unable to operate effectively with in-person learning.

- All Nacogdoches ISD facilities will be closed for in-person learning and will transition to remote learning only. The facilities will be closed for deep cleaning of all facilities and buses.
- Persons who are determined to have been in “close contact” (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer) with an individual who is confirmed COVID-19 positive will be personally contacted by phone and will be required to self-quarantine for 14 days and work/learn remotely.
- Individuals in the same class but not considered to be in “close contact” will be notified by letter and asked to monitor symptoms and are expected to return to school upon reopening.
- District/campus communication to staff/parents with health monitoring guidance.
- Only authorized personnel allowed in district facilities
